HOW IT WORKS

The California Film Commission's tax credit program supports eligible film projects produced in California. Contributions made by productions to the Career Catalyst Film Fund meet the career readiness requirement for the tax credit. Funds are made available to support students' wages during paid work experiences.

Career Catalyst oversees the contracting process for selected work-based learning programs that are connecting their students with work experiences at their own organization or in partnership with businesses in the film industry.
