YOUR PART

College partners are responsible for the internship design, placement, and managing student performance at the worksite. The Film Commission has outlined the following criteria for internship design:

- 1. Minimum Hour Requirement:** Minimum of 100 hours dedicated to media-related production work.
- 2. Age Requirement:** Must be 18 years of age or older.
- 3. Compensation Alignment:** Aligned with industry standards.
- 4. Engagement with Industry Professionals:** Involving participants in meaningful, project-based assignments.
- 5. Opportunities:** Offer wide range of technical crafts, spanning both production and postproduction.
- 6. Program Summary:** Reflection of internship experiences from students and partnering institutions.
