Program Overview

The Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander (AANHPI) Student Achievement Program, in collaboration with the California Commission on Asian and Pacific Islander American Affairs (CAPIAA), the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (Chancellor's Office), and Asian Pacific Americans in Higher Education (APAHE), is dedicated to empowering AANHPI students. Through culturally responsive services, this program aims to enhance the educational experiences and success of underserved students, particularly those who are first-generation and low-income.

As the Central Office, the Foundation for California Community Colleges (FoundationCCC) serves as a statewide hub by providing technical assistance to colleges, creating statewide collaborations, and maximizing holistic resources for students, faculty, and staff. By honoring the intersectional needs of AANHPI students, FoundationCCC and its partners strive to create transformative impacts that allow students to thrive in their educational journeys.

- Culturally responsive learning communities
- Advising and counseling services
- Mental health counseling and awareness services
- Career development, career readiness, and employment services
- Supplemental instruction, tutoring, and developmental support
- Course and curriculum development in Asian American and Pacific Islander studies
- Leadership development, internships, and mentorships

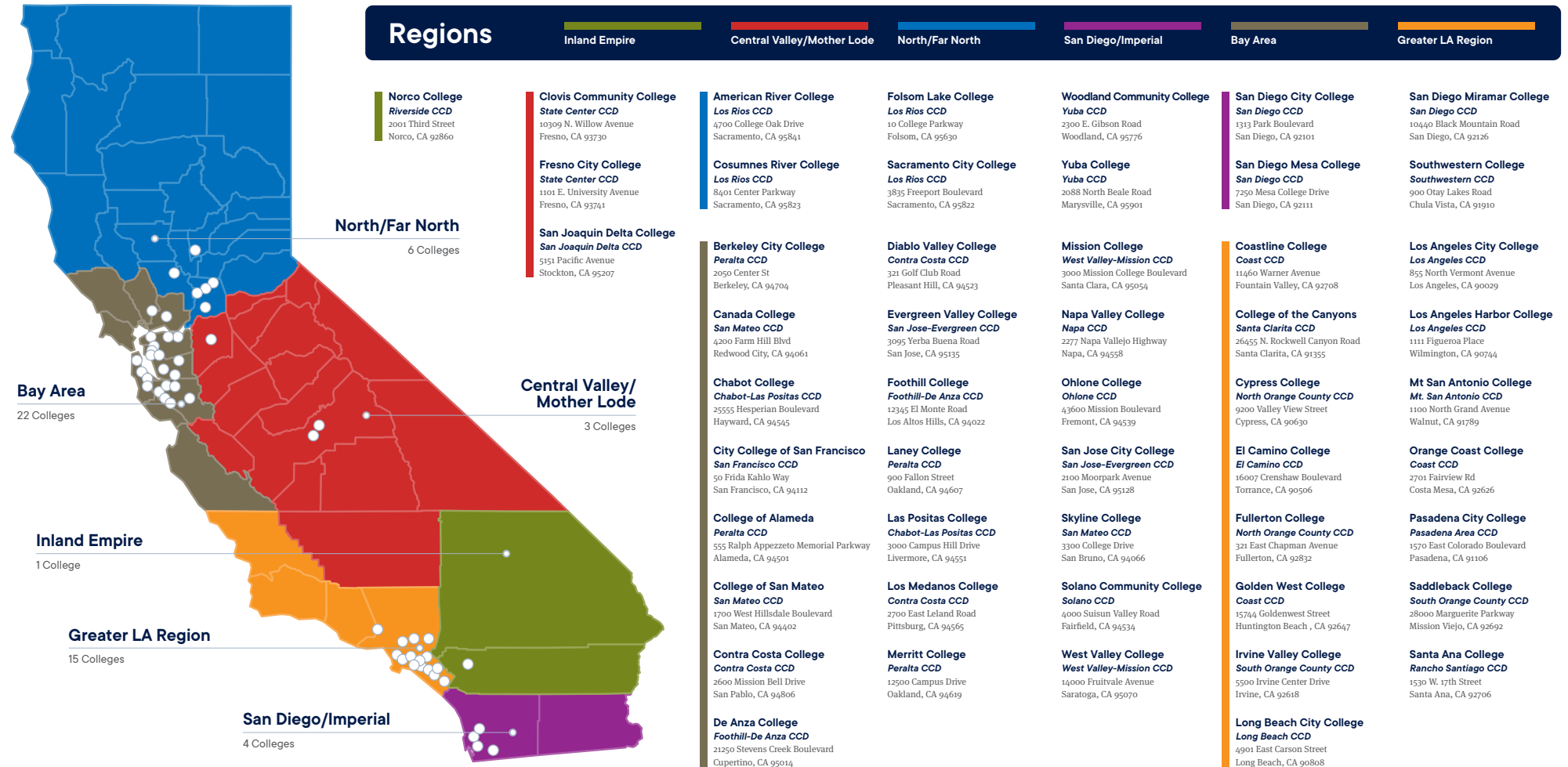
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2024-2025 Fiscal Year Program Map
